




PROFESSIONAL RENEWABLE ENERGY CERTIFICATE

CU-Boulder's professional certificate in renewable energy is available for online distance learners, non-degree-seeking students, and working professionals of all levels who are looking for new careers or leadership positions in the field of renewable energy. This graduate-level certificate program provides an in-depth study of renewable energy technologies, policies, and business.



Those completing the three-course program earn a professional renewable energy certificate, granted by the Graduate School of the University of Colorado Boulder.

Build a Foundation in Renewable Energy

Upon completion, participants will be well qualified for leadership positions in the renewable energy industry and have insights into critical issues such as the following:

- Which renewables have the greatest short and long-term promise?
- The changing costs and pricing for renewables.
- How federal and state policies affect growth.
- Key challenges and barriers to growth.
- Identifying business, commercial, and career opportunities.

Admission Requirements

The program is accessible to both technical and nontechnical students who meet the following requirements:

- Undergraduate degree from an accredited university.
- Ability to read and write in English and complete a term paper.
- Ability to do basic math.

Certificate Requirements

It takes one to two years to complete the certificate. Though not required, it is recommended that one start the program in the spring and take the following full-semester courses in this order:

- RSEI 5000 Energy Science and Technology, taught by Keith Stockton, Ph.D.
- RSEI 5001 Renewable Energy Policy, taught by Paul Komor, Ph.D.
- RSEI 5002 The Business of Sustainable Energy, taught by Steve Lawrence, Ph.D.
